Infectious Diseases

I. Viruses

A. DNA Viruses

- 1. Adenovirus causes 10 varieties of the cold
- 2. Cytomegalovirus commonly found in stillborn babies
- 3. Epstein-Barr Virus mononucleosis; "kissing disease" (causes sore throat, fever)
- 4. Hepatitis B Virus causes life-long liver infection
- 5. Herpes Simplex #1 causes cold sores
- 6. Herpes Simplex #2 STD, causes genital herpes and warts
- 7. Human Papilloma Virus causes genital warts and plantar warts on feet
- 8. J C Virus causes white matter to form in the brain (disrupts nervous / immune system)
- 9. Parvovirus life-threatening to dogs and hogs
- 10. Varicella-Zoster Virus causes chickenpox (child) & shingles (adult) / (irritates skin)
- 11. Variola Virus causes smallpox (eradicated in 1980) / (produces skin lesions)

B. RNA Viruses

- 1. Filovirus causes Ebola (hemorrhagic fever) / (can bleed to death within 10 days)
- 2. Flavivirus causes Denge Fever (bleed to death), St. Louis Encephalitis (inflamed CNS),
 & West Nile Virus (disrupts neurological functioning)
 transmitted by mosquitoes
- 3. Hantaan Virus causes an accumulation of mucus in lungs no way to prevent (potential epidemic)
- 4. Hepatitis A Virus causes fever, abdominal pain, nausea
- 5. Human Immunodeficiency Virus leads to AIDS
- 6. Influenza A causes the flu; highly contagious
- 7. Morbillivirus causes measles (extremely contagious; no extreme effects) given MMR vaccine by 15 months
- 8. Mumps Virus causes inflamed lymph glands (given MMR vaccine)
- 9. Rubivirus causes rubella (German Measles) / (pregnant women are at high risk) given MMR vaccine
- 10. Poliovirus causes stiff neck, possibly paralysis
 once treated with the Iron Lung (AIDS epidemic of the 1940's / 1950's)
- 11. Respiratory Syncytial Virus causes viral pneumonia in children
- 12. Rhabdovirus causes rabies by being bitten (organisms become furious and paralyzed)
- 13. Rhinovirus causes 100+ cold varieties; "nose virus"
- 14. Rotavirus causes 24 hour flu

II. Bacteria

- 1. Bacillus anthracis causes anthrax (attacks immune system)
- 2. Borrelia bargdorferi causes Lyme Disease (arthritis)
- 3. Chlamydia trachomatis causes STD (genital inflammation)
- 4. Clostridium botulinum causes botulism (food poisoning)
- 5. Clostridium tetani causes lock jaw
- 6. Corynbacterium diptheriae causes Whooping Cough (respiratory tract infection)
- 7. Escherichia coli causes food poisoning
- 8. Heliobacter pylori causes stomach ulcers (due to lowered immune response)
- 9. Lactobacillus acidophilus ferments milk
- 10, Mycobacterium leprae causes Leper's Disease (body parts "decay off")
- 11. Mycobacterium tuberculosis causes tuberculosis (fever, chills, & affects respiratory tract)
- 12. Mycoplasma pneumonia causes walking pneumonia
- 13. Neisseria gonorrhoae causes gonorrhea (STD); genital sores, pain
- 14. Neisseria meningitidis causes meningitis (inflamed brain and spinal cord)
- 15. Rickettsia rickettsia causes Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever (fever, chills)
- 16. Salmonella causes typhoid fever (food poisoning)
- 17. Staphylococcus normally found in mouth, throat, and on skin
- 18. Streptococcus pneumoniae causes pneumonia (mucus build-up in lungs)
- 19. Streptococcus pyogens Strept Throat
 - Scarlet Fever
 - Rheumatic Fever (antibodies attack body tissue)
 - Flesh Eating Bacteria
- 20. Treponema pallidum causes syphilis (STD); sores
- 21. Yersinia pestis causes the Black Plague (blood clots too much)

III. Protists

- 1. Entamoeba histolytica causes traveler's diarrhea (found in contaminated food)
- 2. Gessherium catanellum release nerve toxin (causes Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning)
- 3. Giardia lamblia causes traveler's diarrhea (fecally transmitted (salad bars / day cares))
- 4. Gonyaulax excavata causes red-orange tides
- 5. Leishmania donovani causes fever, spleen-liver problems, death (passed by sand flies (Gulf War))
- 6. Phytophthora cinnamoni destroys avocado, eucalyptus plants
- 7. Phytophthora infestans caused Potato Blight in Ireland in 1845
- 8. Plasmodium malarie causes malaria (fever, chills) / (passed by mosquitoes)
- 9. Plasmopara viticola causes downy mildew on grapes

- 10. Pneumocystis carinii major cause of death of AIDS patients
- 11. Saprolegnia ferax causes water mold in aquariums
- 12. Toxoplamsa gondii causes toxoplasmosis (carried by cats)
 life-threatening to fetuses (can cause mental impairments)
- 13. Trichonympha campanula found in termite guts (digests wood)
- 14. Trichomonas vaginalis causes inflammation of the vagina
- 15. Trypanosoma cruzi causes American Sleeping Sickness (passed by the Reduvit bug)
- 16. Trypanosoma gambiense causes African Sleeping Sickness (passed by the tsetse fly)
 attacks nervous / immune system (person may fall into deep, fatal sleep)

IV. Fungi

A. Common Molds

1. Rhizopus solonifera - "Black Bread Mold"

B. Sac Fungi

- 1. Ceratocystis ulmi causes Dutch Elm Disease (imported from Holland)
- 2. Endothia parasitica causes Chestnut Blight (wiped out American Chestnut in eastern U.S.)
- 3. Morchella esculenta "Morel Mushroom" (found in late April, early May)
- 4. Neurospora crassa "Red Bread Mold" (studied extensively in genetics)
- 5. Saccharomyces cerevisiae bread and beer yeasts
- 6. Sarcoscypha coccinea "Scarlet Cup Fungus"
- 7. Tuber melanosporum "Truffles" (found in oak roots by pigs) / (European delicacy)

C. Club Fungi

- 1. Amantia very poisonous toadstool (bright red, yellow, or white = poisonous)
- 2. Boletus varilpes edible, choice mushrooms (salads, pizza)
- 3. Calvatia gigante giant puffballs
- 4. Cantharellus cinnabarinus edible, choice mushrooms
- 5. Fomes "Bracket Fungi" (found on trees)
- 6. Phallus ravenelii stinkhorn mushrooms in yards
- 7. Puccinia graminis "Wheat Rust" (major problem for farmers in 1930's)
- 8. Ustilago maydis causes corn smut to form (delicacy in Mexico)

D. Imperfect Fungi

- 1. Aspergillus niger used to make Beano
- 2. Aspergillus terreus use to make Lactaid (lowers cholesterol production)
- 3. Candida albicans causes thrush infections in mouth & urinary tract
- 4. Microsporum audouini causes ringworm & Athlete's Foot
- 5. Penicillium notatum used to make penicillin (discovered by Alexander Fleming)
